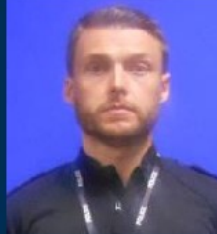

## What matters to you

### #YOU SAID, WE DID

**You said: Anti-social behaviour was a priority.**

This month, there have been an increased rise in the amount of Nitrous oxide Canisters found especially in communal parks across the Beat. These have been left in large quantities at the road side. Residents are reminded that under new legislation Nitrous oxide Cannisters are now classed as a Class C drug and are illegal. Anyone found to be in possession of these will be dealt with.

**You said: Road safety continues to be an issue**

Officers conducted a speed check in Barton in the Beans last month following multiple reports of excessive speeds. We are happy to report that most vehicles checked were found to be driving within the specified limit with only four cars stopped for speeding with words of advice given.

**You said: Rural Crime is priority (Burglary)**

Burglary continue to be an ongoing issue across the beat with offences taking place in sporadic areas at different times. Officers from the Beat Team and Response have been doing late night patrols across key hotspot areas as well as visiting victims of crime to hand out our burglary packs and offer reassurance and crime prevention advice.

## What we are doing

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will prioritise the following in October 2023.

### **Priority 1: Road Safety**

**You said:** That Road Safety issues are your number 1 concern.

**What we are going to do:** Conduct speed checks throughout areas that are known to have a high volume of traffic.

### **Priority 2: Antisocial Behaviour (ASB)**

**You Said:** Anti-Social Behaviour including use of motorbikes on open spaces was an issue to you.

**What we are going to do:** Conduct patrols of key areas reported to us, deal with offender through a multiple agency approach.
