TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

FOOTPATH FROM QUORNDON RISE TO OAKMEADOW WAY, GROBY

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

A footpath closure is required on Footpath from Quorndon Rise To Oakmeadow Way, Groby on the 23rd November 2021 for 2 days.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for **Leicestershire County Council** to facilitate footpath patching and any other associated work to the highway.

The proposed alternative diversion route will be via: Oakmeadow Way, Garendon Way, Quorndon Rise, Groby and vice versa.
