TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER

MARKFIELD ROAD AND MARKFIELD ROAD SERVICE ROAD, RATBY

Leicestershire County Council Highways has agreed to a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order at the above location.

A road closure is required on Markfield Road between the junction with Main Street / Groby Road and property number 110 Markfield Road from 12th July 2021 for up to 3 weeks.

In conjunction with the work taking place on Markfield Road, access to Markfield Road Service Road will also be limited. Local residents will be provided information by the contractor carrying out the work on how they will maintain / gain access to their properties.

The Temporary Traffic Regulation Order will be implemented for public safety for **Miller Homes, their Contractors and any other required utility** to undertake the necessary work for the new development, including the creation of new speed cushions and carriageway resurfacing work.

The proposed alternative diversion route during the Markfield Road closure will be via: Ratby Lane, Launde Road, Markfield; A50 Leicester Road (Field Head), A50 Bradgate Hill, A50 Markfield Road, Groby Town, Leicester Road from A50, Saceverell Way, Groby; Groby Road, Ratby and vice versa.
