Temporary Traffic Regulation Order

ADVANCE NOTICE

A Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (TTRO) is to be made for the following location:
Ratby Road/Rookery Lane/Fir Tree Lane/Stephenson Way, Groby (see weblinks).

The purpose of the TTRO is to allow **STW and their contractors** to facilitate installation of new apparatus and other associated works as part of a flood alleviation scheme.

The TTRO will incorporate temporary road closures and parking restrictions.

The duration of the restrictions are not anticipated to exceed a period of 13 weeks commencing on the 23rd July 2024.

A Press Release will be issued to confirm these details approximately two weeks prior to the works commencing.

STW will be liaising with local businesses/residents in advance of the works and will also be organising a community drop-in event.

Weblinks/Phase information:

Phase 1- Ratby Road between the junction of Leicester Road and the junction of Fir Tree Lane for 6 weeks; including a closure on Rookery Lane (access maintained). 3-way traffic signals will be used in conjunction with the closure on Ratby Road.

Phase 2- Ratby Road between the junction of Fir Tree Lane and the junction of Martinshaw Lane for 7 weeks; including a closure on Stephenson Way (access maintained). 2/3-way traffic signals will be used in conjunction with the closure on Ratby Road <https://one.network/?tm=GB138347539>

Parking restrictions on Ratby Road and Fir Tree Lane Groby will be used when required during the duration of the works.
